- Juniors must have an adult to accompany him/her on ALL weapon activities

Camp Info

- Dog Soldiers (Red Armbands) are available to help with any questions or issues
- NO DRINKING WATER AVAILABLE ON SITE
- Fire Restrictions May Apply – bring an alternate cooking source
 - (i.e. enclosed above-ground fire-pit / charcoal container, or gas cooking source).
- Leave No Trace: Fill fire pits and pack out all trash
 - HAUL IT IN, HAUL IT OUT!!!
- Dogs on leashes only – clean up after them
- No feminine products, dog poop bags, or trash in porta-potties
- Separate Primitive & Modern Campsites
- No curfews – This is a rendezvous, so be aware of whom you set up next to; they may be late night revelers.
- Children must be supervised at all times. All Pee-Wee activities must be accompanied by parent/ guardian. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behavior of their children.
- Pre-1840 Dress Required after registration until prizing ends on Sunday
 - Non-compliance = dress point deduction
 - This includes the entire Rendezvous site (primitive and non-primitive)

2 miles veer L onto Dry Buck Rd/NF-644
6 miles R on High Valley Rd/644
½ mile R on Lantern
Veer L on High Valley
Continue to Pratt Place

FROM BOISE
Hwy 55 north to Horseshoe Bend
At light Left onto Hwy 52
9 miles Right onto Sweet/Ola Hwy
OR

FROM EMMETT
Hwy 52 to Sweet/Ola Hwy,
Left onto this rd.
THEN
17 miles to (just past) Ola,

Then right onto High Valley Rd (forestry Rd 644)
Approx. 10 miles to camp
(When 602/644 T's, veer right staying on 644
In High Valley L on Lantern
Veer L on High Valley
Continue to Pratt Place
